

As you want to become a registered user of the endgame study database HHdbV, you are about to give me permission to store your personal data only for the following purposes:

- To identify you as a registered user of HHdbV.
- To help you out when you must download HHdbV again (e.g. hardware failure).
- To be able to inform you if the update HHdbVI will be issued.

This is what I register: name, address, e-mail-address, download code, downloaded or not, dates (ordering, payment, download), amount paid. This data is only accessible by me, and I do not provide it to anyone, nor use it for any other purpose than mentioned above. The data is not stored on-line, except for the download code and downloaded or not (i.e. not connected to the other data), and the payment details (which includes your e-mail address and payment) via PayPal.

Of course, you may ask me to remove your personal data from my database, by sending an e-mail with that request to [info@hhdbv.nl](mailto:info@hhdbv.nl). This however means that you would no longer be a registered user of HHdbV, and, as a consequence, must refrain from using it and you must delete the database, any subsets or export files from your computers and all other devices. Also other versions of the database (e.g. prints) must be destroyed. Further, by Dutch tax law I must keep the orders for a minimal period of 7 years.
